

FirstPROOF 6.2

Upgrades

If you are upgrading to FirstPROOF 6.2 from a previous version of FirstPROOF, then there are a few things you need to be aware of:

1. This is a chargeable upgrade (except if upgrading from FirstPROOF 6.1) and to run it you will need an Upgrade Key. If you have registered FirstPROOF in the last 12 months (that is any time during 2013), then you should be eligible for a complimentary upgrade. Please contact your supplier to check if this is the case and for further details.
2. Version 6.2 can read all the configuration settings from earlier versions of FirstPROOF. However, this is a one-way process (earlier versions of FirstPROOF clearly know nothing about version 6.2).

If upgrading to FirstPROOF 6.2 from an earlier release, please read the documents “FP v6.1.0 README”.

Supported OS's

The following was true as of FirstPROOF 6.1, but we are re-stating it here for clarity.

As of FirstPROOF 6 we are dropping support for older operating systems and CPUs:

1. Windows NT, Windows 2000, and Windows Vista are no longer supported (XP is).
2. Mac OS9 (or earlier) is no longer supported.
3. Mac PowerPC based computers are no longer supported.

Furthermore, we are stopping all official support for versions of FirstPROOF older than 5.2. We will provide limited support for FirstPROOF 5.2, but if any issues encountered are things that are broken in FirstPROOF 5.2 but work in FirstPROOF 6.2, then the solution will be to upgrade to FirstPROOF 6.2.

Mac OSX compatibility

FirstPROOF 6.2 on the Mac now supports OSX 10.9 (Mavericks).
